

Special Measures in Effect in the Event of the Suspension or the stoppage of the Saint-Laurent Soccer Club Activities Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic in 2021.

The Saint-Laurent Soccer Club started its 2021 outdoor season in April 2021. In early April 2021, practices were held outside with groups of eight (8) players with one coach, respecting the strict sanitary guidelines (hand washing with hand sanitizer, physical distancing, mask at all times for 10 years old and older).

The Saint-Laurent Soccer Club has adopted special measures that could be applied should its activities be suspended indefinitely or for a precise period or completely stopped because of a decision by the Government of Québec and/or the “Direction Nationale de la Santé Publique du Québec”. In such a situation, though it has no control over the situation, the Club must remain proactive.

The Club has adopted measures that make it possible to carry over member registrations until the moment where the activities can restart. This means that when the Government of Québec and/or “Direction Nationale de la Santé Publique du Québec” gives the green light to relaunch youth organized sports, all the members who were registered at the time the activities were suspended or stopped, will be considered to be already registered and could immediately resume playing.

This special carry over measure is applicable to members of all age groups, except for Senior categories. For Senior categories, please refer to the last paragraph. The modalities of this carry over also depends on the date the activities were stopped or suspended and the length of time remaining in the 2021 outdoor season. In the case of a complete stoppage that would end the 2021 outdoor season, the percentage of registration fees that would be carried over to registration for the 2021-2022 indoor season will be set along the following criteria:

Recreational and Competitive Programs: In the case of a temporary suspension of its activities, Saint-Laurent Soccer Club will try and prolong the 2021 outdoor season through the month of October 2021 in such a way as to not affect the member registrations. In the case of a complete stoppage of the 2021 outdoor season, only players registered in the CDC-2 recreational program who have not participated in practice or another activity with Saint-Laurent Soccer will receive a complete refund. As soon as a registered player takes part in practice or any other team activity during the 2021 outdoor season, said player would be eligible for a credit only for the following season, according to the chart above. These Special Measures will take effect in the event of the suspension or the stoppage of the Saint-Laurent Soccer Club activities due to the Covid-19 Pandemic 2021. These measures do not apply to Senior teams. If there is no season for Senior teams, senior players will be reimbursed 90% of the registration fee. If there is a season, players will receive a reimbursement in accordance with the chart above, should the league activities be completely stopped before the month of August.
